- I will respect the facilities and the property provided and it must not be shared with other members or non-members of King's Elite Goaltending Academy.
- I will behave appropriately in 1:1 sessions, webinars and on the King's Elite Goaltending Academy Facebook pages at all times.
- You may record 1:1 and webinar sessions for personal use, however these are not to be posted on any public forum or social media platforms. Screenshots are acceptable.
